PURPOSE

To reduce and eliminate behavioral health disparities in Kansas by welcoming people who are not all like each other in an educational series of meaningful conversations about culture.

OVERVIEW

This series of 5 statewide sessions will involve speakers and leaders from communities of people in Kansas who have been marginalized and experience behavioral health disparities, sharing their passions, hopes, ideas, and culture to promote healing and improving behavioral health for all. This year's series will focus on specific audiences of communities experiencing behavioral health disparities in Kansas and involves support from the Mid-America Prevention Technology Transfer Center. An anticipated outcome of this series is that people from marginalized community groups will have the opportunity to share their thoughts, feelings, and opinions on prevention efforts in Kansas and about their culture's needs and strengths specific to substance misuse and suicide. Another desired outcome from this series is that the KPC will build our capacity to provide more culturally responsive services.
